

# Turkish Forum 2026 – Project Evaluation Scoring Scale

Projects will be assessed by jury the members on a scale of **100 points**. Evaluation system is consists of **5 common criteria** applicable to all projects and **five specific criteria** unique to the application field. Each criteria will be scored out of **10 points**, for a total score of 100.

## A. COMMON EVALUATION CRITERIA (For all projects)

| 4  | Sustainability and the potential of long-term impact                                                  | 10   |
| 5  | Presentation quality, knowledge of the project team on the subject and the answers given to questions | 10   |

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## B. Specific Crierias for the Engineering and Technology Field

| 6  | Technical competence and the quality of engineering solution                             | 10   |
| 7  | Level of technological innovativeness and AR-GE quality                                  | 10   |
| 8  | Potential of a prototype, product or technology to be commercialized                     | 10   |
| 9  | The contribution it will provide to industry, production or technological transformation | 10   |
| 10 | Scalability and applicability in different Turkic states                                 | 10   |

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## C. Specific Criteria for the Social Sciences Field

| No | Evaluation Criteria                                                           | Puan |
|----|-------------------------------------------------------------------------------|------|
| 6  | Capacity to provide solutions for societal needs                              | 10   |
| 7  | Potential for policy development, governance or institutional contribution    | 10   |
| 8  | Capacity to create cultural, economic or social impact                        | 10   |
| 9  | Scientific adequacy of the research method and data-based approach            | 10   |
| 10 | Potential for dissemination and stakeholder participation in the Turkic world | 10   |

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### Scoring Principles

Each criteria will be evaluated according to the following scale:

| Score | Evaluation            |
|-------|-----------------------|
| 0–2   | Insufficient          |
| 3–4   | Needs improvement     |
| 5–6   | Intermediate Level    |
| 7–8   | Good                  |
| 9–10  | Very good / Excellent |

The arithmetic mean of the scores given by the jury members will constitute the final score of the project. Projects that rank high in each category will be determined according to the final score ranking. In case of a tie, priority will be given to the project with a higher score on the following criterias: added value to the Turkic world, innovativeness and applicability.
